

WSIS (2003 and 2005):

- → "10. We are also fully aware that the benefits of the information technology revolution are today **unevenly distributed** (...) (WSIS, 2003);
- →"8. We recognize (...) the problem in bridging the digital divide, which will require (...) investments in **ICT infrastructure and services**, and capacity building, and transfer of technology over many years to come" (WSIS, 2005);
- →"19. (...) in addition to the public sector, financing of ICT infrastructure by the private sector has come to play an important role (...) **North-South flows** and **South-South cooperation**" (WSIS, 2005).
